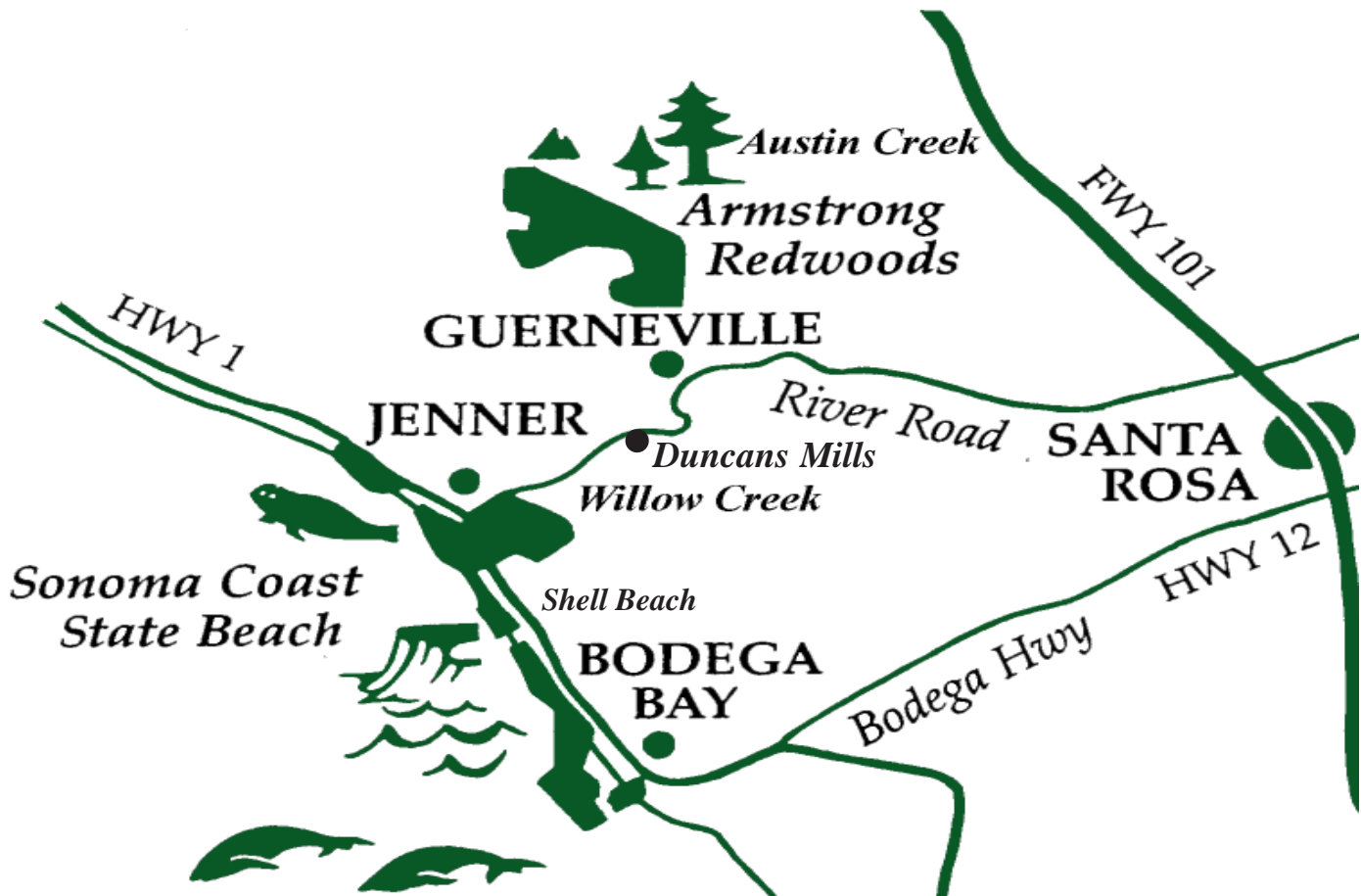

How to Get There



Armstrong Redwoods State Reserve: Take Highway 101 north of San Francisco. Exit at River Road in northern Santa Rosa. Take River Road west to Guerneville. Make a right turn at Armstrong Woods Road, which deadends at the Park entrance.

The Armstrong Grove Hike leaves from the front parking lot.

The Equestrian rides leave from the Pack Station, which is 1 mile into the Park. Follow “Horses for Hire” signs (left fork), turn onto the dirt road by the Armstrong Tree. Drive 1/2 mile past “Authorized Vehicles only” sign.

Duncans Mills: Continue west past Guerneville where River Road becomes Highway 116, pass Monte Rio and follow the signs to Jenner. **Mountain Bike Ride parking** will be near the State Park Sector Office on the south side of the road.

Jenner: For the **paddle** continue west on Highway 116 from Duncans Mills to Jenner. Follow the signs for parking and unloading your kayak or canoe if you bring one.

Willow Creek Watershed: Instead of going right to Jenner when you get to Highway 1, go left over the bridge and make the first left onto Willow Creek Road. Travel about 1/2 mile to the first bridge. Parking will be indicated by signage.

Sonoma Coast State Beach: Continue south on Highway 1. Shell Beach will be just south of Goat Rock. **The Shell Beach parking lot is where both the Coastal Trail Mammoth Hike and the Red Hill Hike will begin.**
